Union delegates set to make their voices heard in Blackpool

This year's CIU Annual Meeting will take place in the Norbreck Castle Hotel, Blackpool.

The hotel's Ballroom will host the Annual Meeting on the morning of Saturday, April 13, which will include a welcome from The Worshipful the Mayor of Blackpool, Councillor Gary Coleman, as well as an address from the keynote speaker Gerry Sutcliffe, the former MP for Bradford South and Minister of Sport, who is now the CIU's Parliamentary Advisor.

The Agenda for the Annual Meeting is shown below with one Motion set to be debated during the session.

The Beer & Trades Exhibition is the other key activity taking place during Blackpool 2019 and this, the 28th edition of the event, will be held on Friday, April 12 in the Norcalympia Suite at the Norbreck Castle Hotel.

The show has grown massively in popularity since its return to the Norcalympia in 2014 with the result that it is now the UK's biggest trade exhibition for the club market.

This event aims to give club members all the advice they need to boost their club's bottom line with expert advice available on all aspects of club business from a host of trusted suppliers.

The Union's Preferred Supplier of gaming machines, Dransfields, will be one of the main exhibitors at the show, alongside fellow Preferred Suppliers Heineken UK – who will be running a bar showcasing their key products for the club market – and Aon UK and BOC.

Each delegate will receive a set of complimentary drinks tokens on entry and there will be plenty of opportunities to win prizes throughout the afternoon.

Urmston Men's Club & Institute is buzzing with activity all through the year

URMSTON MEN'S CLUB & INSTITUTE

Urmston Men's Club & Institute in Greater Manchester has been at the heart of its local community for just under a century and continues to offer a fantastic all-round experience to its 1,000-plus members

Established in 1922, Urmston Men's Club & Institute has been part of the local community for nearly a century and continues to expand what it offers in order to remain highly relevant in the 21st century.

With just over 1,000 members on its books, the club is busy seven days a week with an array of activities taking place in the large spacious club which boasts a well-appointed Lounge, Bar, Games Room with three full-sized snooker tables and Concert Room, while outside stands a magnificent Bowling Green overlooked by a Terrace.

While the club enjoys a high profile in its community thanks to the hectic schedule of live entertainment, sport and other regular social and cultural events which take place within its walls, the club's Committee is determined to ensure that as many local people as possible realise just what a gem they have on their doorstep.

"We've really upped our game on

Facebook over the past year as it's a brilliant way to keep in touch with our members, not to mention future members," says Club Treasurer Kirsty Vanden.

"There are Facebook group pages for events in the local area so when we have something on at the club we can post our event on those groups and it increases the awareness of the specific event as well as boosting the club's profile. The best thing about advertising yourself on social media is that it's completely free.

"We also find that Facebook is great for flagging drinks promotions. For example, for St Patrick's Day in March, we ran a promotion in the club with special deals on Guinness and Jameson's whiskey.

"We've also run 'Happy Two Hours' promotions where you get 30p off a pint of lager between 7pm and 9pm on a specific night and that was also publicised on Facebook.

"It's also quite easy on social media to

measure how many people you're reaching.

"When I took over the club's Facebook page back in June of last year, we had about 700 'likes' on each post and that's now gone up to 1,100 'likes' on posts so it's clear that it's having some effect on boosting awareness of the club and what we have to offer."

But, of course, the main purpose of this renewed social media blitz is to get more people through the doors of the club and the hard work seems to be paying off with plenty of new people from the area getting involved with the club for the first time.

"We got 50 completely new members on the last round of subscriptions and many of them would probably have heard about all the benefits of membership in the first place through our posts on social media.

"It gives you a platform to let people know, for example, that we have great snooker and pool tables and it will only cost you 20p for a game.

“One of the problems you have as a members’ club is that many people have a preconceived notion of what they entail and can be put off from venturing in,” says Kirsty.

“Obviously we have ‘Men’s Club’ in our name so if you didn’t know the reality you might think that means that women are not welcome, which is absolutely not the case. As soon as they walk in for the first time, they realise that it’s a great place to come,

“But it only takes a single visit and you’ll realise that everyone is welcome whether you’re male or female, young or old. It’s a great place that offers entertainment and drinks at a fantastic price.”

The club has long enjoyed a stellar reputation for its live entertainment and that tradition continues with bands, singers and comedians performing there regularly.

“Our Committee Members work really hard at getting some fantastic acts into the club and we have a real mix of bands and singers, including tribute acts – most recently the U2 Experience – which are really popular with our members.

“We’ve also tried to think outside the box a bit and approached acts who have a big following on social media and invited them to perform at the club.

“For example, we’ve got a great comedian playing in October as part of her tour after we contacted her directly via social media. We sold a load of tickets as soon as we announced the event.

“Every Friday we have a Karaoke Night and on Thursday night we have Bingo and Play Your Cards Right and we’ll also have regular discos as well as special nights playing Motown and Northern Soul.”

Recently, the club has made huge efforts to ensure that the club is family friendly.

“That’s an important thing these days as it ensures that you are safeguarding the club for future generations by nurturing future members at an early age,” says Kirsty.

“We want to let young people in the area know about our fantastic pool and snooker facilities which they can use for a fraction of the price they pay elsewhere,” says Kirsty.

“In addition, we have a ‘Juniors Section’ in our Concert Room when there’s a big football match on so that they can enjoy the game in a fantastic, safe atmosphere.

“We also held a big Children’s Christmas Party with Father Christmas, live acts and party food and a couple of months prior to that we staged a Family Halloween Party with disco, fancy dress competitions and

party games. Both were complete sellouts!”

Live sport is very popular at Urmston Men’s Club and the club offers both BT Sport and Sky Sports. “We have three large screens and when there’s a big match we put it on in the Concert Room,” says Kirsty.

“Last year, when England were doing so well in the World Cup, we put on all the Three Lions games in the Concert Room and had around 200 people filling the place so it was absolutely brilliant,” she says.

“We’ve also had some great crowds in this season for both the Premier League games at the weekend and UEFA Champions League midweek matches, particularly the games involving City and United.”

Sport is part of the DNA of the club and the club boasts a fantastic Bowls Green at the rear of the club with two teams competing in the District League as well as a veterans team.

“The Bowling Green is renowned as one of the best surfaces in the area and we have some very successful teams. The B team won the local Knockout Cup in 2018 so the whole club was delighted with that achievement,” says Kirsty.

“Our Terrace is a really great place for members to enjoy a drink during the warmer months – particularly as its south facing – and relax while watching the bowling.

“As I said earlier, we also have a great Games Room and we have snooker, pool and darts teams who all compete in the local competitions.”

Private functions are another key revenue earner for the club.

“We hire out the Lounge or Concert Room for private events and we can also provide the catering for any occasion – parties, wedding receptions, or wakes – so that’s a great income for the club,” says Kirsty.

“It really is a great club and we’re determined to ensure that everyone in the area knows about what we have to offer.”

MEMBERS' CORNER

Eating carrots and drinking green tea are good for us, according to researchers at the University of Southern California.

The compound ingredients found in green tea and carrots were tested on laboratory mice which had been genetically programmed to develop Alzheimer's.

One of the tests used was putting the mice through a specially designed Y-shaped maze to analyse their memory.

This experiment showed healthy mice explored both arms for food and eventually found their way out, while the genetically bred mice with Alzheimer's struggled.

After the experiment, the physically impaired mice were fed, for three months, a special diet containing extracts from carrots and green tea - FA (ferulic acid) and a compound known as EGG which is extracted from green tea.

Researchers noted after the mice who ate the special diet were put through the same maze test again, they were able to complete it as their memory appeared restored.

This suggested to researchers the special diet had helped to protect the brain and repair memory loss in the mice. The ingredients also appeared to have greatly reduced the inflammation in the brain which is another key symptom in humans with Alzheimer's.

The mice went through various tests both before and after being fed the special diet with evaluations very similar to the cognitive and memory tests used by therapists and doctors to diagnose people with Alzheimer's and Dementia.

The study supports the idea that plant based combination treatments or therapies may be one of the best ways to treat Alzheimer's disease in the same way doctors address other diseases.

Results from this clinical experiment are very encouraging and may open the door in the future for people to have more medical treatments available to help treat memory problems.


