## Major suppliers confirmed for 2019 Trade Show



The Beer & Trades Exhibition will take place in Blackpool during Conference Weekend at the Norbreck Castle's Norcalympia Suite on Friday, April 12

This year's CIU Annual General Meeting and 28th Beer & Trades Exhibition will take place at the Norbreck Castle Hotel in Blackpool.

The morning of Saturday, April 13 will see Union delegates assembling in the hotel Ballroom for the Annual Meeting.

For the fifth year running, the Beer & Trades Exhibition will be staged in the hotel's huge Norcalympia Suite on the day before the Annual Meeting, Friday, April 12.

As in previous years, there will be a host of the Union's Preferred Suppliers exhibiting at the show, including gaming machine supplier Dransfields, Heineken UK and Aon UK, as well as many other club suppliers.

The CIU will have its own stand at the show staffed by Head Office personnel with information available on all the services offered to clubs by the Union, as well as details on the new Award in Club Management.

"Dransfields is once again delighted to support the CIU Beer & Trades Exhibition

in Blackpool," said Dransfields Managing Director Chris Haley.

"It is a great opportunity for us to showcase all the very latest entertainment and gaming machines specifically designed to maximise income for clubs.

As well as suppliers, the Union itself will be running a stall at the Trade Show with a delegation of Head Office staff on hand to talk you through the services that the CIU offers to its member clubs.

We will also have details of how you can earn the new Award in Club Management (ACM), the qualification which aims to give you all the knowledge you need to run your club efficiently and successfully.

Talking of the ACM, I am delighted that in this issue we announce the first batch of club members to have earned the new qualification, having taken part in the day sessions at the end of last year.

If you'd like to earn this qualification, look out for further details of the ACM courses which will be held at clubs across the country over the year.

Once again, some of our clubs have expressed their concern after receiving letters from the Motion Picture Licensing Company (MPLC).

The letter highlighted what it termed 'significant changes to the UK copyright law that will impact clubs with the suggestion that clubs may require a MPLC licence if they show broadcast films or television in public.'

Our officials have been in contact with the MPLC and made clear our position that clubs showing sports coverage, news, weather and live events have absolutely no need to purchase a costly MPLC licence.

We've republished our advice letter regarding this issue on page 15 but don't hesitate to get in touch with your Branch Office if you have any



further concerns or questions regarding the MPLC.

Meanwhile, our Club of the Month for February is Egham United Services Club and you can read about this incredibly well-run club and their amazing national reputation for cask ale on page 11.

I hope you enjoy the issue.

## Maidstone WMC holds Annual Games Presentation

Maidstone Working Men's Club, the oldest CIU club in Kent, founded in 1870 and a member of the CIU since 1875, held its 82nd Annual Games Presentation evening on Saturday, November 10 in the club's Concert Hall.

The winners of the club's winter games were presented with trophies or club drink vouchers for the seven memorial competitions and 10 open competitions that have been played over the last year.



Egham United Services Club has won national renown for its cask ale offering and stages three major beer festivals a year

# EGHAM UNITED SERVICES CLUB

**Founded in 1920, Egham United Services Club in Surrey enjoys national renown thanks to its commitment to cask ale. Indeed, the club is now down to the last four of CAMRA's Club of the Year competition**

**E**gham United Services Club was founded in October 1920 as a social club for ex-servicemen who had returned from World War One.

Having begun life in a humble tin shed, the club relocated to its present, purpose-built building in 1965 and the club has undergone major improvements and refurbishments along the way, resulting in the excellent facilities seen today.

The club has forged a national reputation for its cask ale offering and has been the winner of the Surrey CAMRA Club of the Year competition every year since 2008; has been included in the annual Good Beer Guide for the past 11 years, while its beer festivals have attracted cask ale fans from all over the country.

No wonder then that the CAMRA judges have put them forward for further honours in recent months.

"We are absolutely delighted to be named in the last four of the Campaign For Real

Ale's (CAMRA) Club of the Year at the end of 2018 and this is the third time we've made it to this stage so we're keeping our fingers crossed that it'll be third time lucky when they announce the winner later this year," says Club Secretary Julie Black.

"We've staged three beer festivals a year since 2008 – that's 31 in total so far – and we've served over 2,000 different beers. Because we've done so many, the beer festivals run like clockwork now, although it's always hard work with an army of volunteers drawn from the ranks of the club and CAMRA.

"We have around 50 beers and 15 ciders on during a festival and we're so well known that there's a big crowd of people who come for every festival. We do one at Easter, one in August and then another one in November.

"You do get a lot of new beers on because that's what really gets people in. During the beer festivals, we open at 10am but there'll be a queue outside an hour before.

"Outside of the beer festivals we have two permanent real ales on at all times plus five others which rotate all the time.

"People want to try new beers and so we have a 'beercam' on our website where members can see exactly which beers we have on in real time. For some of the most popular beers we can put a barrel on and within three hours it will be finished.

"Our Social Secretary and beer festival organiser Bob Inman runs beer trips four times a year for members. He doesn't tell them where they're going but will load up 30 people on a coach and go and visit a brewery, sample all their beers and then stop off at a few pubs on the way back before ending up back at the club in the evening.

"We've also run several 'Meet the Brewer' nights at the club where we arrange for a brewery to put on all their beers on at the bar and then the brewer or owner gives a talk about their beers and chats to the members.

## CLUB OF THE MONTH

“We have a very good Bar Manager in Paul Dyer. He’s been with us for several years and always ensures that the beer is kept in perfect condition.”

But the club has plenty of other attractions to sit alongside its excellent beer offering. “We have live music every Saturday night, weekly bingo sessions, quiz nights and snooker and darts teams playing in the local leagues,” says Julie.

“Having so many things going on at the club means that there’s something for everyone and that’s reflected in that fact that our members are all ages. We’re a very child-friendly club so that ensures that you get younger families wanting to join.

“It’s a good mix as you have the older members who have been members for decades as well as younger people coming into the club. We also have several student members from Royal Holloway University which is just down the road.

“In fact, we have a number of students from there who work part-time behind the bar. We aim to welcome everyone and create a fantastic environment.”

“We have an outside patio area which comes into its own during the beer festivals as we set up stillages there. If it’s raining, we can partially cover the area with an electric awning so we can still utilise the outside area whatever the weather.

“We also have a purpose-built barbecue out there which is great for club events, including the festivals.

“Live sport is another major attraction at the club and we show all the Premier

League football on BT Sport and Sky Sports throughout the season and we also show plenty of rugby throughout the year. There’s always a great atmosphere when the big teams are playing and last year’s World Cup was just brilliant.”

As if there wasn’t enough reason already for members to head down to the club, hot and cold food is available at the bar daily, from noon till 9pm, with sandwiches, rolls, pies, pasties, sausage rolls and chips, curry, etc all on the menu.

“We also do a lot of private functions in the club,” says Julie. “We’ll provide buffet

food if it’s required and we will also run a barbecue if it’s a summer party.”

Charity fundraising is a major rallying point for the membership and several Armed Forces charities have benefited from the club’s ongoing activities.

“We’ve raised over £15,000 for various charities over the past six years,” says Julie.

“Our nominated charity for 2018 was Hounds for Heroes which provides specially trained assistance dogs for disabled war veterans and we’ve also supported the Help For Heroes and the Coming Home charities since they were formed.”

“We’re really pleased with how well the club is doing,” says Julie. “We have over 700 members, the club is always busy and we will be celebrating our centenary in 2020.

“We have a very hard-working and effective Committee headed by our President, Alan Purvis, and the club is really up-together with regular refurbishments taking place when required.

“Everyone is very proud of how well the club is doing across the board and all the members, Committee and staff play their part in making it a fantastic place to come.”

## First batch of candidates pass the ACM

**Re: Motion Picture Licencing Company (MPLC) – Demand letters & Applications for Licences**

Over recent weeks we have received enquiries from many clubs for advice regarding correspondence received from the above. We have also received written feedback from MPLC itself having forwarded complaints on clubs' behalf regarding threatened fines and incorrect information received in relation to Sports channels.

The position regarding the requirement for a licence has recently been clarified in writing by MPLC in the following terms:

*The amendment to Section 72 [Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988] does not only cover 'film', but instead it covers any creative work, which will include not only films, but also television shows.*

It has been made clear that a licence is not required for unedited sports coverage or any other TV broadcast which does not contain 'creative work'. This would arguably include (but isn't necessarily restricted to) the following:

- Sports coverage
- News
- Weather
- Live events (such as the recent marriage of Harry & Megan etc)

We have informed MPLC that the majority of clubs with television will use them solely to show sport. They have advised on the following terms:

*It is doubtful that clubs actually know what is being broadcast, and whether films or other creative work are included in the broadcast. Such works frequently come on air, and unless there is someone actively monitoring the content that is being broadcast, you cannot be certain that unlicensed works are not being broadcast and that our studio partners' rights are therefore being infringed.*

In the circumstances our advice to CIU Affiliated Club's is that providing clubs restrict their coverage to sports, news and other events as listed above, they should not need a licence from MPLC or any other similar body.

**Please note that this in no way affects the need for additional licences required to show free-to-air broadcasts in relation to music content by the collective licences provided by PRS and PPL.**

Please keep me updated if you receive any further direct contact which contrasts with this advice or your club receive a complaint or a fine for alleged copyright infringement.

Booking a holiday as soon as the weather warms up seems like a good idea and there are plenty of enticing holiday bargain priced packages out there as the tourist industry heats up and prepares to get ready to for the Spring and Summer breaks ahead.

However, there are some precautions to take if you are considering booking with a tour company online that you have not heard of before. Take the time to make sure they really do represent a genuine business with the required protections and guarantees before you hand over deposits or payments.

With so much choice it can all seem a bit confusing when you are looking to book up and search for the best deal. When booking a holiday, be sure to check exactly what any online quote includes. Prices can go up after a booking and you may be required to pay the difference. Check terms and conditions

carefully and read those hotel or resort reviews.

Make sure you know how to make any changes after an initial booking. If a change is required look to see what additional costs may be involved.

Check your tickets for any random mistakes or a 'no financial protection' clause.

Unfortunately, after March this year it is still very unclear how travel within the European Union Countries will be affected by Brexit. Check and make sure a passport or drivers licence is not out of date, or if the country you are visiting requires any other documents for identification, before you leave home.

An AFI is short for Advanced Passenger Information. Online agents may not be likely to do this for you so you must remember to enter all the relevant information required for you or your family members travelling with you.

If you plan this year to travel to the USA, you will need a valid passport and what is called an ESTA Visa before you leave. In some cases, you may also be asked to show proof of holiday insurance.




