## Clubs required to act on pensions re-enrolment



Further information on pensions re-enrolment can be found on the Pensions Regulators website at: [www.tpr.gov.uk/info-re-enrol](http://www.tpr.gov.uk/info-re-enrol)

Every three years an employer has a legal duty to assess and re-enrol eligible staff who are on, or have left, their automatic enrolment workplace pension scheme. This is known as 're-enrolment'.

You must then submit a re-declaration of compliance to inform the Pensions Regulator that you have done this, even if you have no staff to enroll.

You will have received a letter from the Pensions Regulator informing you of the need to do this.

There are two stages you must complete:

### Stage 1 – Re-enrolment Duties

Go to: [www.tpr.gov.uk/re-enrol-tool](http://www.tpr.gov.uk/re-enrol-tool) to help choose a date.

Choose your re-enrolment date from within a six-month window, which starts three months before the third anniversary of your automatic enrolment staging date and ends three months after it.

On your re-enrolment date you'll need to assess your staff. A list of staff that you do NOT need to assess is on the Pensions Regulator website.

You will need to include anyone who: has left your pension scheme; stayed in

your pension scheme, but has chosen to reduce the level of pension contributions to below the minimum level and who meets the age and earnings criteria to be re-enrolled.

Within six weeks of your chosen re-enrolment date you will need to write to the staff you have put back into your pension scheme to inform them. Template letters are available to download from [www.tpr.gov.uk/employers/re-enrolment](http://www.tpr.gov.uk/employers/re-enrolment)

### Stage 2 – Re-declaration of Compliance

Whether you have staff to put back into your pension scheme or not, you must complete and submit your re-declaration of compliance by your deadline. The declaration and checklist is available on [www.tpr.gov.uk/re-enrol](http://www.tpr.gov.uk/re-enrol)

You must do this within five months of the third anniversary of your automatic enrolment staging date.

### BT Sport confirms 2019/2020 subscription pricing for clubs

BT Sport has confirmed its pricing structure for clubs for the new season by announcing a 2.7% increase in the cost of a subscription, an increase which conforms to the broadcaster's price guarantee which promised that any increase this season would not exceed the annual rate of inflation.

The firm also announced a new free BT Sport Sprint Team service which is available for both new and existing club customers.

### New Premier League season kicks off on Friday, August 9

The new Premier League season will get underway on Friday, August 9 with Liverpool v Norwich City, live on Sky Sports.

Sky's opening weekend coverage continues on Saturday, August 10 as Aston Villa return to the top flight with a trip to face Tottenham, who begin a first full season in their new stadium.

The opening weekend culminates in Sky's first Super Sunday of the season, with Arsenal making the trip to Newcastle United, before Ole Gunnar Solskjaer begins his first full season in charge of Manchester United with the visit of Europa League winners Chelsea.

Sky Sports will be showing 128 exclusively live Premier League games, including Saturday 5.30pm tea time matches, the new Saturday 7.45pm kick offs, Super Sunday double header, Monday Night Football and Friday Night Football.

BT Sport, meanwhile, will be showing 52 live Premier League matches exclusively live for the 2019/20 campaign, as well as coverage from the FA Cup, all the action from the UEFA Champions League and Europa League games and the FA Community Shield match on Sunday, August 4.

BT Sport will primarily broadcast the 12.30pm matches on Saturday throughout the 2019/20 campaign.

BT Sport's first game of the Premier League season is West Ham v Manchester City at London Stadium.

The broadcaster will also be showing the European Super Cup clash between Champions League winners Liverpool and Europa League victors Chelsea on Wednesday, August 14.





## BADDELEY GREEN WORKING MEN'S CLUB

**Exactly one hundred years ago, Baddeley Green Working Men's Club in Stoke-on-Trent became a member of the CIU and a century later its members are set for a fantastic weekend of celebration**

**I**n terms of significant documents signed in 1919, it may not rank as highly as the Treaty of Versailles, but the ornate certificate which hangs on the wall of Baddeley Green Working Men's Club in Stoke-on-Trent means a huge amount to the members of the club.

The document in question is the official certificate, dated July 5, 1919, which confirmed the club as a member of the Working Men's Club & Institute Union.

"We're very proud to be part of the Union and affiliated to an organisation which speaks out for the interests of members' clubs," says Club Secretary Dave Perkin.

"It's a great achievement for the club that we're still going strong all these years later and continue to be such an important part of the local community and that's why we will be celebrating this milestone in July.

"The club actually started out housed in a small wooden hut on a different street before moving to the current location.

"Obviously since then the building has been upgraded and extended with the result that members now enjoy fantastic facilities."

One of the most notable features of the club is the recently revamped Bowling Green at the rear of the club.

"We've invested a considerable amount of money in the Bowling Green over the past few years to produce a fantastic playing surface with the result that bowling is a really big part of the club in terms of attracting players to the club and in retaining existing members," says Dave.

"We currently have teams competing on Saturdays, Mondays and Wednesdays so it's very good for the club. Every year we stage a doubles tournament at the club whereby experienced players are paired up through a draw with a non-bowls playing club member.

"We put up a cash prize – the winning pair received £90 each last year – and it's an event which everyone really looks forward

to. This year's competition, which is sponsored by a local firm, Ridgway Caterers, is going to take place as part of our 100th Birthday weekend.

"We also host indoor short mat bowls at the club, including county matches, which means that you can play bowls all year round at the club."

The club is a focal point for the local community with activities taking place at the club throughout the week.

"We have a running club based at the club, Stoke Fit, who meet at the club on Monday and Wednesday evenings," says Dave.

"They were a small club with no base and approached us to become part of our club and it has really taken off with the result that they now have 210 members, all of whom are members of the main club.

"We also have a homing pigeon racing club, an Over-55s group, a walking club, line dancing, Zumba, yoga, Slimming World,

and a quiz team. We have pool and darts teams which compete in the local league.

“At the moment, we’re trying to get a snooker team up and running as there has been a surge of interest in snooker in recent months from some of the younger members of the club.

“We ran a big Blind Doubles darts tournament in November in aid of the British Legion and the Douglas Macmillan Hospice and that was very well supported with over 100 players and eight dartboards in operation at the same time with the final played on the stage.”

Live entertainment is another big winner for the club with acts performing every weekend. “We’re very well known in the area for providing some brilliant acts,” says Dave.

“My Committee colleague Ant Munday runs the entertainment side of things at the club and he does an unbelievable job in terms of the great acts he books. Recently we’ve had a number of very popular tribute acts – including Abba, David Bowie and Queen – and they were all sellouts.”

A member of the club for over 40 years, Dave has now been Secretary for 10 years, having taken on the role during an anxious time for the club when it found itself with debts of around £70,000.

A new leadership team came in and turned the club’s financial fortunes around with the result that it is now in a very strong position.

“We’ve made a profit every year bar one for the past decade,” says Dave.

“As a club we’ve had to adapt and try new things in order to keep moving forward. We do a lot of private functions throughout the year and that’s a valuable source of income for us.”

Members can enjoy roast dinners on Sundays when the club’s fully equipped kitchen is rented out to a local caterer.

“The food is excellent as well as being great value for money and that brings a lot of people into the club,” says Dave.

A great drinks offering is also crucial to the club’s continuing success and real ale drinkers are certainly well catered for.

“We do two real ales during a normal

week and we’ve also hosted an annual beer festival for the past three years,” says Dave.

“The inaugural one was a great success so we’ve carried on from there and this year we’re running it over our celebration weekend.

“It works very well for us as we tend to get several local suppliers to sponsor a barrel each in return for promoting their name and services so selling the beer means a healthy profit for the club.”

And the celebration weekend is certainly shaping up to be one hell of a party. On Friday, July 5, rock band Trafford Park will be performing before local DJ Phil Ankers spins some floor-filling tunes. On the Saturday, there’s a bingo session plus live music from The Sound Party.

Then on Sunday, July 7, it’s the aforementioned inter-club bowls doubles tournament followed by more live music from duo Young and Foolish in the evening.

With the real ale flowing all three days courtesy of the beer festival, it’s guaranteed to be a fitting way of marking such an auspicious milestone for the club.

No doubt members will take the time during the weekend to raise a toast to the next 100 glorious years of Baddeley Green Working Men’s Club.

**MEMBERS' CORNER**

**Informative articles which affect our life by Dione Mobley**

As of June 1, there is good news for the thousands of people living in private rented properties. This is due to several big changes drafted into law.

These changes have been made to help those living in rented accommodation and aim to benefit many private tenants with assured tenancy, students, or those living with a live-in-landlord.

Before these laws were passed people often found they were expected to pay various added administration fees to agents when seeking new rental accommodation. However, most of these fees have been removed and should no longer apply.

There will still be a security deposit to pay but the amount you will pay for a property will be capped. Landlords or agents can only charge a maximum of five weeks in rent as a deposit.

It is still legal to be asked for a holding deposit but this amount will also be limited to only one week's rent. Landlords must return a holding deposit within 15 days or put it towards the first month's rent or the tenant's security deposit.

When signing a new tenancy agreement or if you are thinking of renewing your current contract, you should not be asked to pay fees for referencing, credit or immigration checks, administration fees or for renewing the current tenancy agreement with your landlord.

If asked for any of these payments, or you disagree with a landlord or a letting agents charges you have the right to report this as over charging fees has become illegal in this country.

Some charges will still be the tenant's responsibility and these include charging for the replacement of lost keys or if your rent exceeds more than 14 days by being late or you want to terminate a tenancy early.


