Dransfields CIU Charity Raceday set for November 17

Dransfields CIU National Charity Raceday takes place on Saturday, November 17 at Wetherby



The 2018 Dransfields CIU National Charity Raceday will take place on Saturday, November 17 at Wetherby Racecourse.

This annual event is one of the biggest dates in the Union calendar and will see a special raceday package available to CIU members for £17.50 a ticket.

The package includes Paddock Enclosure admission, a racecard, exclusive use of the CIU Marquee, money-off-a-pint vouchers courtesy of Heineken UK and 'Pie & Peas'.

The CIU has held its National Charity Raceday at Wetherby since 2006, and during this time the event has raised over £33,000 for various designated CIU charities with over 16,000 CIU members having enjoyed a fantastic day out with club colleagues from all over the country.

Wetherby is renowned as one of the friendliest racecourses in the country and boasts some superb facilities, having undergone a recent £3.5 million redevelopment in the past two years.

Last year saw over 1,200 Union members attending the CIU Raceday with a total of £2,544 raised for the CIU's Education Programme thanks to a donation of £1 each from Wetherby Racecourse and the caterers CGC Events for every package sold to a Union member.

Jonjo Sanderson, Chief Executive and Clerk of the Course at Wetherby Racecourse, is anticipating another great event in November.

"As always, everyone at Wetherby is looking forward to Dransfields CIU National Charity Raceday and getting ready to put on a fantastic day for all our many friends from the CIU," he said.

"We will be providing some quality entertainment both on and off the track with seven jump races to enjoy throughout the afternoon."

Union President George Dawson CMD added: "I would urge clubs to get behind this event as it's a really great day out for our members with the racecourse providing some tremendous Yorkshire hospitality as well as plenty of exciting National Hunt racing.

"As an added bonus, by coming along you'll also be contributing to the Union's Education Programme."



The Carlton House Club in Olney, Buckinghamshire



THE CARLTON HOUSE CLUB, OLNEY

The Carlton House Club in the village of Olney, Buckinghamshire, near Milton Keynes, is doing great business thanks to its high-quality offering of food and drink, plus a busy schedule of activities and events

Around 12 years ago, the Carlton House Club in the village of Olney, Buckinghamshire – population 6,500 – found itself experiencing a major slump in trade.

Despite a prime location on the village High Street, the imposing Victorian club was struggling to attract members and looked to have an uncertain future.

Scroll forward to 2018 and the club is positively thriving with 900 members enjoying top-class facilities, a fantastic drinks and food offering and a wide range of activities.

“We’re very proud of our club and how it has been transformed in the past 12 years,” says Secretary George Horncastle.

“Formerly the place had been looking a bit tired and was failing to get sufficient numbers through the door but the whole club was turned around by my predecessor as Secretary, Mike Smith, and Bar Managers Richard and Viv Stone.

“Between the three of them, they totally revitalised the club and took it from being a few months away from closure to the success it is today.

“Mike sadly passed away some six years ago but Richard and Viv are still at the helm doing a fantastic job and, along with the current Committee, have continued to build on the fantastic legacy laid down by Mike.

“The club has been updated over the past few years with the result that it’s very modern and comfortable,” says George.

“We have four bars in total, including the Function Room at the back which is very popular for private functions, including weddings.

“We also hold regular club events, for example, in August we had a ‘Rum & Reggae Night’ with a live band and rum cocktails which was a tremendous night.

“We also have a large garden with a play area for children and recently upgraded all the furniture so that has been a tremendous

selling point of the club, particularly with the summer we’ve had.”

Central to the club’s renewed success is the great bar offering with a wide range of drinks available at very reasonable prices.

“Before they came here, Richard and Viv ran a pub in the village and know their stuff, running an incredibly high-quality operation here,” says George.

“We have Cask Marque accreditation and have four cask ales on the bar at any one time, including our ‘house’ ale, St Austell’s Cornish Best, and three guest beers which constantly change.

“Allied to that we have several keg beers and lagers on offer – including John Smith’s, Foster’s, Heineken and San Miguel – so there’s a great selection.

“We also keep up with the latest drinking trends, like for example, the renewed interest in speciality gins and mixers and offering gin cocktails has proven very popular with our members.

“We hosted a recent ‘Gin & Swing Night’ and that was a major success and also held a special ‘World Gin Day’ event.”

The club upgraded and expanded its kitchen six years ago and food is now a very important part of what the club has to offer with Richard Stone and son Josh providing some excellent fare at very competitive prices.

“We do lunch from Wednesday through to Saturday and dinner from Wednesday to Sunday, plus a Sunday Carvery,” says George.

“They put on some great promotions, for example, we had a ‘Steak and Strawberries’ offer over the summer which was a steak meal followed by strawberries & cream for two and a bottle of wine, all for £20.

“The food is top-quality throughout and for events they will work with the clients to produce a bespoke menu. The private function side of things has been going really well, particularly wedding receptions, and John and Viv work really hard at providing a perfect occasion for the bride and groom.

“We produced our own wedding brochure to showcase the Function Room and that’s something which brings in a valuable income to the club.”

Live sport is another attraction for members with the big matches shown on the 13 x 9 foot screen in the Function Room.

“We had a brilliant World Cup and really created a fantastic atmosphere in our Function Room with the large projector screen,” says George.

“The place was packed for all the England

games and we had special drinks promotions during the tournament to add to the excitement.

“We’re also the only place in the village with both Sky Sports and BT Sport so that is another great benefit for our members during the football season as we show all the Premier League and Champions League games.

“We also keep the old club traditions going, including regular day trips for members,” says George.

“In July, we took around 50 members up to Skegness for the day and in December we have an annual coach trip to one of the big Christmas markets. Things like that are really important to the club and the members love it and as soon as we get back they’re already planning the next outing!

“We also have bingo twice a week which always draws a good crowd of regulars,” says George. “It’s a really sociable occasion and when I came on board as Secretary, I volunteered my services as bingo caller and I’ve been doing it ever since, which is great.”

The club is determined to appeal to as wide a cross section of people as possible and recognises that getting young involved with the club is crucial, hence the introduction of a special reduced membership rate for 18 year olds.

“We’ve also introduced certain incentives for all members,” says George. “When you renew your membership in December, you get a £5 voucher to spend in January.

“Another thing we did over the summer was give away free ice pops over the bar for kids when their parents were buying drinks.

There are also ballroom dancing lessons on Monday and Tuesday evenings, weekly Zumba classes, a fortnightly Quiz Evening, pool, darts and bar skittles.

Regular charity events are also held at the club, including a special Easter Egg Raffle which raised £550 for good causes in 2018, while several club members are taking part in the Great North Run. The club also has regular collections for the local hospice.

“It’s a great club to be part of,” says George. “There’s always something going on and we want to continue providing the best possible all-round experience for all our members.”

October date for next CORCA meeting

CIU officials will be attending the latest Committee of Registered Clubs Association's (CORCA) meeting on Tuesday, October 16 in London.

Among the topics up for discussion by the various club organisations in attendance will be the recent correspondence sent out by the Motion Picture Licensing Company (MPLC) to clubs.

The CIU has made it clear to its member clubs and to the MPLC itself that a licence is not required for clubs showing unedited sports coverage or any other TV broadcast which does not contain 'creative work',

namely sports, news, weather and live events.

The advice from the CIU is that providing clubs restrict their coverage to sports, news and other events as listed above, they should not need a licence from MPLC or any other similar body.

CORCA comprises the club organisations which represent around 4,500 affiliated non-profit making private members' clubs, including the CIU, the Association of Conservative Clubs, the Alliance of British Clubs and the National Association of Labour and Socialist Clubs.

Latest PRS For Music clubs tariff enclosed

The latest tariff for members' clubs from PRS For Music (PRSM) (effective as of August 1, 2018), is enclosed with this issue as an eight-page supplement (front cover, pictured right).

The CIU has negotiated a special discount for its clubs with PRSM, the organisation which collects and distributes licence fees for the use of music on behalf of songwriters, composers and performers.

PRSM represents over 110,000 songwriters, composers and music publishers with a repertoire of some 14 million musical works.

The PRSM licence covers clubs for all music played through radios, CDs, streaming on the internet, music on TVs and also live music performances.

1. Scope of tariff
This tariff applies to performances of copyright music within PRS for Music's repertoire* at clubs being established and conducted in good faith as non-profit-making members' clubs capable of carrying:

- the conditions for determining a qualifying club for the purposes of Part 1 of the Licensing Act 2003 for England and Wales, or
- the conditions prescribed for the purposes of section 125 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 by reg. 2 of the Licensing (Clubs) (Scotland) Regulations 2007 for Scotland, or
- the conditions for registration under the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 for Northern Ireland.

It does not apply to establishments whose main object is to give to youth or proprietary clubs.

Forward to an Order of the Copyright Tribunal dated 7 October 2013, this tariff does not apply to premises operated by non-profit amateur sports clubs that qualify for tariff AM6.

2. General conditions
This tariff is subject to PRS for Music's General Conditions Applicable to Clubs and Licenses, available on request from PRS for Music.

3. Royalty rates
Where the music user has applied for and obtained PRS for Music's licence before musical performances commence, the standard royalty rate will be charged and payable for the first year of the licence.

Where the music user has not applied for and obtained PRS for Music's licence before musical performances commence, the higher (standard plus 50%) royalty rate will be charged and payable for the first year of the licence.

After the first year of the licence, in either case, the standard royalty rate will be charged and payable.

The following rates of charge apply to all music as falling due from 1st August 2017.

With just a few more months before the festive season starts, a recent survey looked at the actual cost of the Christmas holidays.


